

## Minimum state immunizations requirements for school

### Pre-K

DPT/DTaP 5 doses If the 4<sup>th</sup> dose was given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday only 4 doses required.

Polio 4 doses If the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose was given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday only 3 doses required.

MMR 1 dose

Hep B 3 doses

Varicella 1 doses or verification of the chickenpox disease

Hep A 2 doses

Pneumococcal 1 dose

Hib 3 doses

### K-2

DPT/DPaT 5 doses. If the 4<sup>th</sup> dose was given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday only 4 doses required.

Polio 4 doses. If 3<sup>rd</sup> does if given on or after the 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday only 3 doses required..

MMR 2 doses

Hep B 3 doses

Hep A 2 doses

Varicella 1 dose or verification of the chickenpox disease

### 3-12

DPT/DPaT/TD 4 doses. If the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose was given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday only 3 doses required. Then booster every 10 years.

Polio 3 doses-3rd dose must be given on of after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.

MMR 2 doses

Hep B 3 doses

Varicella 1 dose or validation of chickenpox  
If given after age 13, 2 doses required

It is recommended that children 6 months through 12<sup>th</sup> grade receive the influenza immunization
